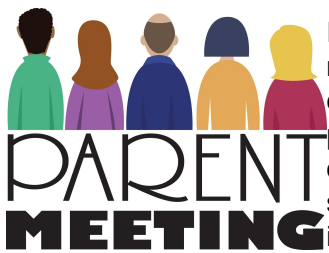

STANDARDIZED TESTING RESULTS -- UPCOMING IOWA/COGAT ASSESSMENTS PARENT MEETING



Iowa Assessment scores for students in grades 1st-8th will be going home in students' red folders today. The Iowa Assessments measure student growth and progress in the content areas assessed from year to year. Your child's scores will indicate how he/she performed on the tests compared with students across the nation in the same grade during the same time of year. The Iowa Assessments help teachers identify a student's strengths as well as areas that may need additional emphasis. These results provide information that helps teachers in evaluating instruction.

Please take some time to read the narrative provided by the testing agency to assist you in interpreting your child's results. Please note additional information provided with your child's scores. You may want to discuss the test results with your child, and if you have any questions, please contact your child's teacher. The teacher may refer you to the appropriate counselor if further assistance is necessary. The counselors will be offering an Iowa Assessments Parent Meeting on Tuesday, May 23rd at 6:00pm in the library. The presentation will focus on helping parents understand how to interpret the scores on the Student Profile Narrative. We invite you to join us if you would like to learn more about the Iowa Assessments. No RSVP is necessary.
